CURRICULUM

Academic Curriculum: Advanced Placement, College Dual Enrollment, Gifted, Honors, Regular, Exceptional Education and Career/Technical Enrollment.

Mathematics: Through College Algebra, College Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus and AP Calculus AB, BC,

Science: Physics, Chemistry, Chemistry II, Ecology, Environmental, Physical Science, Biology, Anatomy and Physiology, Earth Space Science, Marine Science, and Biology II (Forensics). All science courses have two labs weekly.

Foreign Languages: French, German, Japanese, Latin, Spanish/Spanish Speakers, and Portugese

Language Arts: Required courses include study of language, composition, and literature (World, American and British). Elective courses include Humanities, Writing, and Journalism

Social Studies: American Government, Economics, World History, American History, Psychology, Sociology, International Relations, Global Studies, and Human Geography.

CLASS RANK: Both the unweighted and weighted scale are used to determine rank. All courses are counted in determining class rank with one additional point given to a grade of "C" or higher in honors Pre-Calculus, Trigonometry, Statistics, Analytical Geometry, Japanese, and foreign languages beyond the second year and two additional points given, for advanced placement and college dual enrollment classes beginning with the 2005-06 school year.
